
It's Not Too Late - The last 7 minutes

My dad was dying with dementia, and we were uncertain of his spiritual condition. It was 3:33 p.m. on Sunday, November 7th when I noticed the time and was reminded of Jeremiah 33:3, so I quoted a "broken" portion of the verse to Dad; thankfully, Mike was there to share it in full:

Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

I then put the verse in simpler terms for him - and told him that God hears us and promises to answer when we call on Him. Dad's noisy breathing quieted while we shared that verse. *He was most definitely listening*.

Mike then told the story of Nicodemus (John chapter 3) about being born again - a spiritual rebirth. He shared John 3:16 with him and explained what that meant, and then prayed a simple salvation prayer of commitment to Jesus. As I said "amen", Dad's countenance immediately changed to a look of peace and he relaxed and quietly proceeded to finish his life on earth at 3:40 p.m. with no struggles and no discomfort. He just eased into eternity. I believe what he *heard and believed* at the end gave him the confidence to put his trust in God and let go of this life.
