

This year, I attempted something I didn't know if I could do. I took my 58-year-old body, got on my 40-year-old 10-speed bicycle, and prayed and pedaled my way across the United States, from the Oregon Coast to Washington, DC.

Not knowing if I was even capable or what I might discover along the way, it was a remarkable adventure to say the least.

As we began to pray and intercede for every state we pedaled across, we discovered that each state had its own distinct set of blessings, challenges, and strongholds. Some of the towns we went through aren't even there now, places that fires have totally destroyed.

I got to talk with some protesters, pray with some amazing people, and see some of the best and worst of the United States; so I believe our perspective is a unique one. After pedaling 3117 miles over a three-month period, here are some of my observations.

- 1) The true nature of the American spirit and the American people is not what you see on the news. Most people care deeply about their families, their communities, and their country. There are a lot more Christians than one might think, and it's bigger than denominational lines.
- 2) There is a growing anticipation of something coming. Many have shared with us a growing hunger for the reality of Christ, not only for themselves, but for their communities as well. And there is a growing sense that something is about to happen a fresh wind of the Spirit of God, a divine move of God. We too have felt this so strongly as we have prayed across America.
- 3) America is at a tipping point. We will go one way or the other. We will either see a spiritual awakening or we will fall into secular humanism, but we won't stay the same. I'm asking God for revival in the land.

We found churches experiencing revival, growth, and the moving of the Holy

Spirit, while finding other churches who are missing opportunities, closed to outsiders, or just simply closing their doors.

My heart has literally ached as we pray and cry out to God for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit across the land, and it starts with us.

Three things I believe we need to do:

- 1. Allow God to search our hearts. (Psalm 139:23-24)
- 2. Be sensitive and yield to the correction of the Lord.

(Revelation 3:19 John 15:2)

3. Believe God for the greatest outpouring we have ever seen!

(Joel 2:28-32)

There are many things that bring people together for the first time; this summer, for us, most of them included a bike, a bus, or a dog.

I'll never forget Jewell, who gave up on Christianity because of legalistic teaching, and is now entrenched in New Age beliefs. She didn't want me to pray with her because she knows that God answers prayer and might ask something that she isn't willing to give.

My heart was deeply touched by James and his need for a Father's love. Growing up without his parents, his heart is sensitive and ready to know God.

Would you pray for God to finish the work He has begun in these three?
